
AUSTRALIAN COMPETITION AND CONSUMER COMMISSION

Qantas Airways Limited (Qantas) and British Airways Plc (BA) in relation to a restated Joint Services Agreement dated 3 April 2000 between Qantas and BA and related and consequential coordination of schedules and pricing between the parties.
