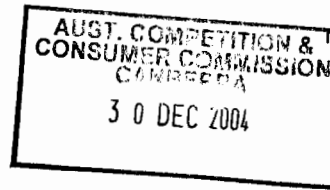

SERVO SAVERS PROMOTION

I refer to previous correspondence and in particular to my e-mail to you of 30 July 2004 with enclosures (copies attached).

Enclosed please find:

- (a) 33 x Form G for various service station proprietors in Queensland.
- (b) Cheque for \$3,300.00.

I note that ACCC has already made a favourable ruling on (almost) identical conduct (at least in terms of Section 47) by service station proprietors associated with Coles and Woolworths.

Whilst participating businesses and service stations have only been signed up in Queensland, the Servo Savers promotion is Australia wide in the sense that coupons can be redeemed at any particular service station wherever situate.

To date there are 33 participating service stations and 350 participating businesses who have signed agreements to participate in the Servo Savers promotion. The agreements entered into are all in the form of the pro forma agreements forwarded with my e-mail of 30 July 2004.

I act for Servo Savers and refer to our telephone conversation on Wednesday.

Servo Savers and associated companies are in the business of conducting reward programs for local businesses. In the past, the rewards have been such things as free shopping up to \$250,000.00 at nominated stores or participation in a draw for a house and land package.

Servo Savers proposes to conduct a new reward program whereby local businesses reward their customers for shopping with them by way of discounted petrol offers. Each reward program will be confined to a particular geographical area, starting with country towns and possibly moving to include Brisbane (on a sector by sector basis).

The discount offer is pre-printed on the back of cash register rolls by Servo Savers which cash register rolls are provided to participating businesses.

The participating business pays Servo Savers a monthly fee based on the number of qualifying sales given out by the participating business.

The discount offer is 4 cents per litre to a maximum of 30 litres per docket provided the customer has met the minimum spend requirement.

A customer may use up to 3 dockets for each purchase of 30 litres of petrol from the participating service station provided that each docket is from a different participating business (i.e. the customer may achieve a discount of up to 12 cents per litre for 30 litres).

Attached is a copy of a pro forma agreement which Servo Savers proposes to enter into with participating businesses.

Servo Savers also enters into agreements with participating service stations whereby the service station agrees to provide discounts on petrol purchased by customers of the participating businesses with valid dockets as described above.

Servo Savers then redeems all valid dockets used to purchase petrol from the service stations for \$1.00 per docket irrespective of amount of petrol purchased by the holder of the docket.

A copy of the pro forma Service Station Agreement is also attached.

Servo Savers has approached a number of service stations to participate in the reward program and has been queried by the service stations as to whether Servo Savers has approval or authorisation from ACCC for the reward program. I gather the queries are arising due to the considerable publicity about the Coles and Woolworths petrol discount programs and that Coles and Woolworths have ACCC authorisation under the Trade Practices Act.

Servo Savers does not consider that it is breaching any of the provisions of the Trade Practices Act or similar legislation or that an authorisation is needed under the Trade Practices Act. I do not consider that the conduct of Servo Savers comes within Section 47 of the Trade Practices Act. Additionally, Servo Savers does not consider that the reward program could possibly amount to anti competitive conduct or the substantial lessening of competition in a market.

I would be grateful if you could confirm that there is no need for Servo Savers to apply for an authorisation of the reward program described above.

The Company is the promoter of Servo Save. The Client desires to become a participant in Servo Save and this the company has agreed to subject to the terms of this agreement.

The parties agree and declare as follows:

1. **Servo Save Dockets** The client agrees to use exclusively the cash register docket rolls as supplied by the company on the terms and conditions of this agreement. Each docket will entitle customers of the client to the Servo Save offer of discounted petrol provided the customer has spent the minimum spend with client as set out in the Schedule. the Servo Save discount rate for petrol iscents Per litre to a maximum of 30 litres at any one visit to any participating petrol station nominated by the company at its discretion.

2. **Clients Obligations** The client agrees to use its best endeavours to promote the Servo Save program to its customers. The client shall: (a) display such point of sale material as provided by the company from time to time including logos, reward offers, any signs and literature with the view to communicating to existing customers the benefits of the Servo Save discounts and to attract new users; (b) co-operate in making customers who spend below the agreed minimum reward spend (as specified in the Schedule) aware of their entitlements if they increased their spend; (c) to state their minimum spend for reward on cash register dockets if possible.

3. **Exclusivity** Subject to clause 4, the company agrees that it shall not appoint any other participants to the Servo Save program who have businesses which are in the same business category as the client's business (as specified in the Schedule) in the same area listed in the schedule.

4. **Maximum Quantities** Client agrees that should the actual number of applicable transactions in any month exceed the estimated number of applicable transactions stated in the Schedule by more than

10% then the participation fees for that month shall increase proportionally

5. **Financial Matters** (a) The client agrees to pay the company a once only Merchant joining fee of \$1850.00 plus GST (b) The client agrees to pay monthly participation fee as specified in the Schedule by way of periodic payments or credit card. Client is to provide the company with a signed periodic payment or credit card authority on the date of this agreement.

6. **The Company's Obligations** The company agrees to (a) regularly and for the term of the agreement supply all cash register docket rolls to the client as specified in the Schedule. (b) Supply Servo Save point of sale material from time to time to the client for display in the client's business premises. (c) Supply a brochure detailing each participating business in the exclusive area and listing the relevant particulars of the client. and updating this brochure as necessary. (d) conduct a once only advertising promotional campaign at the commencement of Servo Save program including distribution of brochures including clients details. (e) keep the client aware of any matters regarding petrol, price forecasts, feed back from consumers that come to it's the Company's notice. (f) to use best endeavours to train staff in the nearest participating petrol stations and other participating businesses.

7. **Term** The minimum term of this agreement is for 12 months commencing from the later of the date of this agreement or the date of commencement of the Servo Save program.

8. **Termination** (a) Either party may terminate this agreement at the end of twelve (12) months from the commencement of client handing out Servo Save dockets by giving the other 60 days notice in

writing of such intention to terminate. (b) The company may terminate this agreement by seven (7) days notice if the client is in breach of this agreement by giving notice in writing which client fails to rectify such as breach within the seven (7) days of receiving the notice. (c) Upon termination of the agreement the client agrees to return by express Australia Post at its expense all material including point of sale and all cash register rolls supplied by Servo Save in it's possession and to cease immediately handing out any dockets containing any offers of discounted petrol to its customers for the Servo Save program. Servo Save can advise participating service stations of the termination of clients business and refuse to accept clients cash register dockets if client is in default of this agreement. (c) Cancellation after the minimum period of twelve (12) months will not render outstanding dockets void and company will redeem any valid dated dockets outstanding from client's customers. (d) Termination by the Company pursuant to sub-clause (b) will not relieve the client from its obligation to pay the monthly participation fees until the end of the initial 12 month period. The client agrees that any such payments are a reasonable and genuine estimate of the Company's costs and damages.

9. **Distribution** The client must not distribute or sell Servo Save dockets from any other place of business other than that referred to in this agreement or to supply Servo Save dockets to any other party other than its bona fide customers.

10. (a) This agreement shall be governed by the laws of Western Australia. (b) The client agrees to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of Western Australia. (c) The client warrants that it has full power and authority to enter into this agreement.

1. **PARTIES**

1.1 **SERVO SAVERS AUSTRALIA PTY LIMITED, ABN 84 101 610 922 (Servo Savers Australia);**

1.2 [] **PTY LIMITED, ABN [] (Service Station).**

2. **BACKGROUND**

2.1 Servo Savers Australia conducts a reward program whereby local businesses (**Participating Businesses**) reward their customers for shopping with them by way of discounted petrol offers.

2.2 The discount offer is pre-printed on the back of cash register rolls by Servo Savers Australia which cash register rolls (**dockets**) are provided to Participating Businesses for use in their businesses. The pre-printer offer will include a dollar minimum spend amount commencing at \$10.00 in some cases and ranging in \$5.00 increments up to \$50.00.

2.3 The discount offer is 4 cents per litre to a maximum of 30 litres (\$1.20) per docket provided the customer has met the minimum spend requirement.

2.4 A customer may use up to 3 dockets for each purchase of 30 litres of petrol from the Service Station provided that each docket is from a different Participating Business. That is to say:

- (a) one valid docket entitles the customer to a discount of 4 cents per litre to a maximum of 30 litres;
- (b) two valid dockets (from different Participating Businesses) entitles the customer to a discount of 8 cents per litre to a maximum of 30 litres; and
- (c) three valid dockets (each from a different Participating Business) entitles the customer to a discount of 12 cents per litre to a maximum of 30 litres.

2.5 Dockets will have a pre-printed expiry date which will change twice per annum.

2.6 If a customer uses a valid docket to purchase less than 30 litres of petrol the customer will receive the applicable discount on the actual quantity purchased and will not receive any credit for the difference between the actual quantity of petrol purchased and 30 litres.

3. **AGREEMENT**

The parties agree as follows:

3.1 The Service Station will provide discounts on petrol purchased by customers of Participating Businesses with valid dockets on the basis described in clauses 2.1 - 2.6 above.

- 3.2 Servo Savers Australia will redeem all valid docket used to purchase petrol from Service Stations for \$1.00 per docket irrespective of the amount of petrol purchased by the holder of the docket.
- 3.3 The Service Station will deliver all valid docket used to purchase petrol to Servo Savers Australia on a weekly basis together with a completed form as provided by Servo Savers Australia detailing information about purchases of petrol using the docket.
- 3.4 Servo Savers Australia will transfer an amount calculated by multiplying each valid docket delivered by the Service Station by \$1.00 to the bank account of the Service Station by direct transfer within 3 business days of receipt of the docket plus applicable GST.
- 3.5 At the same time the Service Station delivers the docket to Servo Savers Australia the Service Station must also deliver a tax invoice with respect to the amount claimed. Servo Savers Australia will not be obliged to pay any amount to the Service Station unless the Service Station provides a tax invoice in proper form.
- 3.6 Servo Savers Australia shall not be obliged to redeem any docket in respect of which:
- (a) there is less than the minimum spend by the customer recorded thereon; or
 - (b) the docket is delivered to Servo Savers Australia after the expiry date of the docket; or
 - (c) the docket has not been used with respect to the purchase of petrol by a customer of a Participating Business.
- 3.7 Servo Savers Australia shall notify the Service Station details of any invalid docket and will return invalid docket to the Service Station.

4. **TERM**

- 4.1 The term of this agreement shall be 12 months from the date of commencement of the Servo Savers Australia reward program in the geographical area in which the Service Station is situate.
- 4.2 Either party may terminate this agreement at any time without cause by 60 days notice in writing to the other.
- 4.3 Either party can terminate this agreement if:
- (a) the other party commits a breach of this agreement which is not remedied within 14 days of being provided written notice of the breach; or
 - (b) a party being a company being wound up, going into liquidation, having a receiver or administrator appointed or being unable to pay its debts as they become due.

5. The Service Station shall keep the terms and conditions of this agreement confidential and shall not disclose them to any third party without the prior written consent of Servo Savers Australia. The Service Station shall procure that its employees keep the terms of this agreement confidential and do not disclose them to any third party.
6. Servo Savers Australia will provide signage, postage, brokers and other literature from time to time promoting the reward program.
7. The Service Station will display the signage and posters provided by Servo Savers Australia in a prominent position in its business premises and shall use its best endeavours to provide brochures and other literature to its customers.
8. The Service Station will use its best endeavours to encourage its customers to acquire docketts by shopping at Participating Businesses and shall generally use its best endeavours to encourage and promote the reward program.
9. The Service Station agrees that its details including its trading name and location can be included in Servo Savers Australia promotional brochures and like material.
10. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of New South Wales and the parties agree to submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of New South Wales.
11. The Service Station warrants that it has full power and authority to enter into this agreement.
