## CSR Building Products Ltd application for authorisations A90964 and A90965

I refer to the above applications for authorisation received by the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 29 March 2005 and 1 April 2005 respectively.

The ACCC is in the process of assessing these applications but would appreciate further information to assist this process, in particular:

- 1. whether a representative of a trade union will be involved in the negotiation process and, if so, what role they would have:
- 2. the state of industrial harmony within the market for building supply cartage services and whether it can be demonstrated that disharmony would exists in the absence of the proposed collective bargaining arrangements;
- 3. the level of competition in down stream markets for CSR's products; and
- 4. the manner in which CSR's competitors deal with and provide cartage services.

In addition to this, the ACCC requires further information regarding the consent of the nominated parties to the applications. In light of the decision in Jones v ACCC [2003] FCAFC 164; (2003) 200 ALR 234 the ACCC requires that where applications for authorisation are made on behalf of another party, that party must provide written consent.
