**Authorisation application lodged by the Board of Airline Representatives of Australia
A30232**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has made a determination in respect of the abovementioned application for authorisation.

This determination is made today, 7 July 2005. The ACCC has granted authorisation for a period of five years for the reasons set out in its determination. For your information, a copy of the determination is attached.

In accordance with section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974* a person dissatisfied with the ACCC's determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal (the Tribunal) for a review of the determination. Each application must be lodged with the Registrar of the Tribunal on the appropriate form within 21 days of the date of the determination; that is before 28 July 2005. The Tribunal is located in the Office of the Registrar of the Federal Court in each State. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 29 July 2005.
