Trade Practices Act 1974 Application for authorisation lodged by the Councils of Camden, Campbelltown, Wollondilly and Wingecarribee (A90886)

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a final determination in respect of the above application for authorisation which was lodged by the Councils of Camden, Campbelltown, Wollondilly and Wingecarribee (the Councils).

The ACCC has made a determination granting authorisation to the Councils. Essentially authorisation is granted for the Councils to collectively tender for the services of qualified contractors, able to process, market or otherwise dispose of kerbside collected materials. A copy of the determination is enclosed for your information.

The ACCC has decided to grant authorisation for the following periods:

- for the period of the collective tender process up to a maximum of 12 months from the date the final determination comes into effect; and
- for the term of the contracts entered into under the tender process up to a maximum of 15 years.

This determination is made on 16 December 2004. If no application for review of the determination is lodged with the Australian Competition Tribunal within the statutory period, namely by close of business 6 January 2005, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 7 January 2005.
