Third line forcing notification N92133 lodged by The Forest Resort Pty Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) on 14 September 2005. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

The Forest Resort has described the conduct as follows:

Requirement to enter into a Building Contract with Boutique Homes Melbourne Pty Ltd for construction of a dwelling on Lot sold.

Legal immunity conferred by the notification will come into force on 29 September 2005. On the basis of the information you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by this notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
