Dear David,

The Department of Industry, Tourism and Resources understands the ACCC is considering a draft determination on a queue management system for coal vessels at Dalrymple Bay. If the Commission decides in favour of a queue management system, the Department believes that reports should be provided to the ACCC each year by January 21 commencing in 2007. This report needs to provide at least the following information:

- rail, port and other capacity expansion projects completed during the preceding calendar year, including the volume of increased capacity delivered
- the nature of ongoing rail, port and other capacity expansion projects in the preceding year, including an estimated date of completion and the volume of capacity to be delivered
- the nature of any proposed capacity expansion investment along the coal chain for the following year
- the annual total volume of coal exported through the Dalrymple Bay coal terminal for the preceding year
- the nature of ongoing rail, port and other capacity expansion projects in the preceding year, including an estimated date of completion and the volume of capacity to be delivered
- the declared annual coal chain capacity, the volume of allocation utilised during each quarter of the preceding year and the total volume of available allocation for each quarter of the preceding year.

The Department wishes to emphasise it neither supports nor objects to the introduction of a queue management system at Dalrymple Bay.
