**Re: Third line forcing notification N92190 lodged by Kumar Motors Pty Limited
(trading as Peninsula Holden Dee Why)**

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 4 November 2005. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

You have described the conduct as Holden Peninsula Dee Why offering a rebate, credit allowance or discount to Holden customers in relation to the purchase of certain motor vehicles on condition that the customer acquires novated leasing services from TVPR Pty Limited (trading as Holden Leasing).

Legal immunity conferred by the notification commenced on 18 November 2005.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by this notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
