We confirm that despite the additional day during which VISA Cardholders can take advantage of the pre-sale offer, the maximum number of tickets which may sold in the pre-sale period will remain as described in the notifications (ie, no more than 30% of each level of tickets to the Concert).

We also confirm that the 30% limitation on each level of seats which will be offered in the pre-sale period will continue to apply, as Rod Laver Arena is a seated venue.

Finally, VISA has become aware that the Promoter will also make a pre-sale offer of tickets to Rolling Stones Fan Club members (of whom there are approximately 2000 in Australia) prior to release to the general public. This offer is not connected with the VISA-pre sale and Rolling Stones Fan Club members will be able to take advantage of this offer using any payment means.
