**Third line forcing notification No N31538  
lodged by Toyota Motor Corporation Australia Limited (Toyota)**

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 3 February 2006. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

Toyota has described the conduct as follows:

Persons appointed as Authorised Daihatsu Service Agents by Toyota will be required to acquire parts, accessories and components from Eastpoint Pty Ltd (trading as Autoparts).

Legal immunity conferred by the notification commenced on 17 February 2006.

On the basis of the information provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

Please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
