**Re: Investment & Financial Services Association Ltd (IFSA)
applications for revocation and substitution of authorisations - final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (ACCC) has issued a determination granting re-authorisation in respect of the applications for revocation and substitution of authorisation lodged by IFSA on 4 October 2005.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation for five years.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 29 March 2006. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 30 March 2006.
