The Notifications are made on exactly the same basis as the previous Notifications and the same submissions as to the effect on competition are made in relation to the enclosed Notifications.

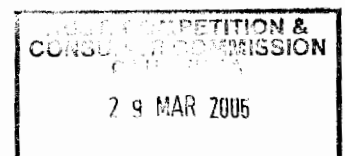


