Re: Third line forcing notification No. N92193 lodged by Saville Australia Pty Ltd on behalf of Mr Charles Raymond Turk Ellis

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 19 December 2005. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

You have described the conduct as follows:

The vendor(s) will require purchasers of allotments in a proposed residential development scheme to also enter into separate contracts for the development of the allotments by a specified builder.

I understand that the proposed residential development is located at 9-11 Edgehill Street, Scarborough, Western Australia.

Legal immunity conferred by the notification came into force on 3 January 2005.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by this notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
