Application for revocation and substitution (A90994-6) lodged by Medicines Australia Inc – Substantive Application

The Department refers to your letter dated 5 December 2005 concerning the above application by Medicines Australia Inc under Section 91C of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*.

The Department provides the following submission in respect of the substantive application made by Medicines Australia Inc. concerning its revocation of the authorisation in respect of Edition 14 of its Code of Conduct ("Code") and substitution of a replacement authorisation of Edition 15 of its Code.

The Department considers the Code is effective in regulating the marketing of prescription products to health professionals in that it ensures such promotion is carried out in a balanced manner and has a scientific basis.

The Code also aims to ensure that information provided to the public on request for prescription products is educational and is not promotional. This complements the legislative prohibition on the advertising of prescription medicines to the general public yet enables the public to obtain current, balanced and accurate information on products if required.

Edition 15 of the Code extensively modifies the existing Code in respect of the distribution of samples to health professionals. This aims to ensure that samples provided to healthcare professionals have been stored in such a manner that their effectiveness will not be compromised. This modification was a recommendation of the Council of Australian Governments Review of all state and territory drugs and poisons legislation (the Galbally review). Consideration is being given to adopting this section of the Code under NSW legislation for the regulation of medicines.
