Final determination**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination granting authorisation in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by your client, Medicines Australia on 30 November 2005.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. The ACCC has decided to grant authorisation, subject to a condition, for three years for the reasons set out in its determination.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 16 August 2006. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 17 August 2006.
