**Third line forcing notifications N31616 lodged by
Calliden Limited (Calliden)**

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) by Calliden on 31 May 2006. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register. I apologise for the delay in responding.

Calliden described the conduct the subject of the notification as follows:

Calliden is proposing to supply various insurance products to *members only* of the following groups and associations:

- Queensland Master Builders Authority – construction material damage, construction liability, builders warranty
- Timber Merchants – industrial special risks, other accident, public and products liability
- Hardware Association – industrial special risks, other accident, public and products liability, fire
- Australian Funeral Directors Association – industrial special risks, other accident, public and products liability, professional indemnity
- Dental Essentials – fire, other accident, public and products liability
- Ultrasound – professional indemnity



- Fire Protection Authority – public and products liability, other accident, fire
- Pest Controllers – public and products liability, professional indemnity, fire
- Australasian Association of Registered Training Organisations – professional indemnity
- AABTh (Beauty Therapists) –professional indemnity
- Australian Camps Association – fire, public and products liability, other accident
- Community Related Insurance and Superannuation Program – public and products liability

Legal immunity conferred by this notification commenced on 14 June 2006.

On the basis of the information provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

Please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by this notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
