**Tabcorp Manager Pty Ltd applications for authorisation A91065, A91066 & A91067
- interested party consultation**

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has received applications for authorisation from Tabcorp Manager Pty Ltd (Tabcorp). For more information on the authorisation process please see the **attachments**.

Tabcorp is seeking authorisation for the 2007 SuperTAB Pooling Agreement (2007 Pooling Agreement) between Tabcorp and TOTE Tasmania Pty Ltd (TOTE Tasmania). The 2007 Pooling Agreement governs TOTE Tasmania's participation in the SuperTAB Pool operated by Tabcorp.

Tabcorp is also seeking interim authorisation to enable Tabcorp and Tote Tasmania to give effect to the 2007 Pooling Agreement while the ACCC is considering the merits of the substantive applications.

A summary of the 2007 Pooling Agreement, a copy of Tabcorp's applications for authorisation and Tabcorp's supporting submission are **attached**.

The purpose of this letter is to seek your comments on the applications as a potentially interested party.

Request for submissions on the applications for authorisation and request for interim authorisation

To assist the ACCC in its consideration of the applications for authorisation, it would be helpful to obtain your comments on the likely public benefits and the likely effect on competition, or any other public detriment, arising from the 2007 Pooling Agreement between Tabcorp and TOTE Tasmania.

The ACCC decides whether to grant interim authorisation on a case by case basis and will usually consider a range of factors including; harm to the applicant and other parties if interim is or is not granted, possible benefit and detriment to the public, the urgency of the matter and whether the market would be able to return to substantially its pre-interim state if the ACCC should later deny authorisation.

The ACCC seeks your comments on the request for interim authorisation by **Friday, 16 November 2007** and on the substantive applications for authorisation by **Friday, 30 November 2007**. All submissions, including oral submissions, will be placed on the ACCC's public register subject to any request for exclusion (guidelines are **attached**).

Timetable

The ACCC will progress its assessment of the applications in a timely manner. An indicative timetable is set out below for your information.
