## Australian Property Institute application for minor variation to Authorisation A90545 - determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination varying authorisation A90545 to allow:

- changes to API's disciplinary rules to provide for an appeal mechanism for decisions made by the Complaints Committee;
  - changes to API's Constitution, By-laws and Rules of Conduct concerning classes of membership, in particular providing for a new Provisional membership class with restricted rights as to the signing of valuation; and
- changes to the privileges section of the constitution.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached.

## Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 5 December 2007. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 6 December 2007.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
