*Re: Sky Channel Pty Ltd (Sky), Tabcorp Holdings Ltd (Tabcorp) & ThoroughVision Pty Ltd (TvN) application for authorization A91031 and A91032 – interested party consultation*

I refer to your letter of 20<sup>th</sup> February 2007 seeking comments in relation to the application as a potentially interested party.

On the information provided Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV) is of the understanding that:

- Sky/Tabcorp and TvN have made an application for authorization of an arrangement - 'Memorandum of Understanding' (MoU) - which in broad terms, details the commercial terms for both Sky and TvN to share the broadcasting of thoroughbred racing content
- This entails two television broadcasts. The purpose of the Sky broadcast will be to facilitate wagering via a consolidated racing broadcast – what punters want. The

purpose of the TvN broadcast will be to showcase thoroughbred racing – what thoroughbred racing enthusiasts want.

- The agreement will effectively end the possibility of ‘split vision’ and enable the introduction of innovative services such as interactive wagering until at least 31<sup>st</sup> December 2012

Given these understandings, at this particular time, GRV does not wish to raise any matters of concern in relation to the application.
