Re: Third line forcing notification N92913 lodged by Jetstar Airways Pty Ltd

I refer to the above third line forcing notification lodged with the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) on 14 May 2007. The notification has been placed on the ACCC's public register.

Jetstar proposes to run a series of promotional campaigns, offering a discount on certain travel bookings made and paid for during a specified promotional period on the condition that consumers pay for such bookings using their MasterCard credit card.

Legal immunity conferred by the notification will come into force on 28 May 2007.

On the basis of the information that you have provided, it is not intended that further action be taken in this matter at this stage.

As with any notification, please note that the ACCC may act to remove the immunity afforded by the notification at a later stage if it is satisfied that the likely benefit to the public from the conduct will not outweigh the likely detriment to the public from the conduct.
