The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination granting authorisation in respect of the above mentioned application lodged by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners on 13 December 2006.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. The ACCC has decided to grant authorisation to the arrangements for four years for the reasons set out in its determination.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 13 June 2007. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 14 June 2007.
