Subject: BP: Cash-in-Transit Notification

Dear Scott,

I trust that you have now received the above Notification I dispatched to you by express post yesterday.

In relation to the two queries you raised in yesterday's telephone conversation, I am instructed by BP as follows:

1. BP's intention is to give both Single Site Franchisees and Agency Franchisees 60 days notice of the proposed arrangements regarding their acquisition of Cash-in-Transit Services.
2. There are currently ten Accredited Providers of Cash-in-Transit Services throughout Australia. In addition, there are a further three providers whose accreditation has recently lapsed. BP would be happy to go through the process of re-accreditation of any of the three providers whose accreditation has lapsed, if requested to do so by an Agency Franchisee.

The number of Accredited Providers in each state is as follows:

- Western Australia: 1
- New South Wales: 2 (and 2 whose accreditation has lapsed)
- South Australia: 1 (and 1 whose accreditation has lapsed)
- Victoria: 2
- Queensland: 4

On behalf of BP, we confirm our request that you provide us with advanced notice if the ACCC intends to contact any of the Single Site Franchisees or the Agency Franchisees in respect of the Notification.
