Application for revocation of authorisation A90954 and substitution of new authorisation A91011 lodged by Canberra After Hours Medical Locum Service – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for revocation of authorisation A90954 and substitution of new authorisation A91011 lodged by Canberra After Hours Medical Locum Service (CALMS) on 12 September 2006.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC grants the authorisation until 30 June 2008.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 8 February 2007.
