Further to my letter of March 13, 2007, Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV) has considered a letter sent to you dated May 25, 2007 by Mr. Andrew Kelly, CEO of the QHRB.

GRV believes that this letter is well constructed.

The letter also raises issues which may not necessarily be explicit in the ACCC draft determination:

Re: Sky Channel Pty Ltd (Sky), Tabcorp Holdings Ltd (Tabcorp) & ThoroughVision Pty Ltd (TvN) application for authorization A91031 and A91032

In this regard GRV wishes to support the general trust of this letter and in particular its summary suggestions in respect of the ACCC draft determination, namely:

- ❖ Define the market of the racing industry as a 'whole' comprising the thoroughbred, harness and greyhound racing codes

- ❖ Unless this definition is made, the MoU may not necessarily provide public benefit to the harness and greyhound codes
- ❖ The MoU needs to consider possible individual code as well as collective industry impacts
- ❖ A condition of increased level of thoroughbred racing (Australian or International) should be that neither harness nor greyhound quantum of coverage be markedly reduced
