Application for authorisation A91058 lodged by Office Choice Limited, Office National Limited and Office Products Depot Limited (collectively the Office Group) – draft determination and request for interim authorisation

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a draft determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Office Group on 12 July 2007.

A copy of the ACCC's draft determination is enclosed. For the reasons set out in its draft determination, the ACCC proposes to grant the authorisation for six years.

Interim authorisation

The ACCC has also decided to grant interim authorisation to the Office Group to allow them to commence collective negotiations with office products suppliers for the 2008-09 supply year.

In making this decision, the ACCC was influenced by the voluntary nature of the arrangements, the absence of collective boycotts and the assurance by the Office Group that should the ACCC deny authorisation any agreements entered into during the interim period will not be binding on the parties.

Interim authorisation protects the collective negotiation between the Office Group and suppliers of office products from legal action under the relevant provisions of the *Trade Practices Act 1974* (the Act) until the ACCC issues a determination in this matter (unless circumstances warrant revocation or amendment of the interim authorisation at an earlier stage).

Please be advised that the ACCC can review its decision on interim authorisation at any stage. Its decision in relation to interim authorisation should not be taken to be indicative of whether or not final authorisation will be granted by the ACCC.

Next steps

Once the ACCC issues a draft determination, the Office Group or any interested party who may be dissatisfied with the ACCC's draft determination may request that the ACCC convene a 'pre-decision conference'. A pre-decision conference provides the opportunity for interested parties to make oral submissions in relation to the draft determination. Under the Act, the ACCC must set a date within 14 days of which any pre-decision conference must be requested. Accordingly, if you wish the ACCC to hold a pre-decision conference in relation to the draft determination, you must notify the ACCC in writing by close of business Wednesday, 22 August 2007. Conferences are conducted informally, without the participation of legal or other professional advisers.

Alternatively, you are also invited to make a written submission in response to the ACCC's draft determination. Written submissions should be lodged by close of business Wednesday, 29 August 2007 at the following address:

Persons lodging a submission with the ACCC may request that information included in the submission be excluded from the public register in certain circumstances. Submissions which are excluded from the public register may still be taken into account by the ACCC when conducting its assessment of an authorisation application. Guidelines for seeking exclusion from the public register are attached for your information.

The ACCC will consider any submissions it receives, including any oral submissions made should a pre-determination conference be called, and will then release a final determination in relation to this application.
