Re: Exclusive Dealing Notification lodged by Racing and Wagering Western Australia

As discussed the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has received an exclusive dealing notification from Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWWA). The ACCC invites your comment on the notification lodged by RWWA. Information about the exclusive dealing notification process is attached.

RWWA is proposing to supply a licence to conduct training duties in the racing industry on condition that horse trainers acquire workers compensation insurance from an insurer specified by RWWA. The specified insurer is yet to be determined by RWWA.

Further information about the conduct RWWA has notified is provided in the attached supporting submission.

Request for submissions

The ACCC invites you to make a submission on the likely public benefits and effect on competition, or any other public detriment, from the proposed arrangements.

If you intend to provide a submission in relation to RWWA's exclusive dealing notification, please do so by **Thursday 23 August 2007**.
