RE: AUSTRALIAN PROPERTY INSTITUTE (API) APPLICATION FOR MINOR VARIATION TO AUTHORISATION A 90545.

Thank you for your referral for my comments of this application to you by the API.

Authorisation A90545 has previously been varied on two separate occasions since the initial approved version in 1994. On both those occasions the Valuer General of WA has had no issue with the proposal or the approval of changes by the ACCC.

My comments relating to each are:

- (1) Changes to the API's disciplinary rules no issues with this.
- (2) Changes to permit a new Provisional Membership Class, including restricted rights as to the signing of valuations. This inclusion will protect the public insomuch as where required it will control unqualified valuers like students from preparing and carrying out unsupervised valuations. This should ensure appropriate governance and training to assist the profession without reducing resources, especially at this time when there exists a general shortage of qualified members of the valuation profession due to overall demand from the property development and finance areas in Australia.

This will allow the flow of valuation work to continue to benefit the public while ensuring such work does no continue unsupervised and is carried out in a professional manner.

(3) The third change is to the constitution's "privileges" section and is understood to only clarify its current meaning, there is no issue with this.
