Authorisation Application lodged by Dairy Farmers Milk Co-operative Limited (DFMC) and Australian Co-operative Foods Limited (ACF) [A91089] – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by Dairy Farmers Milk Co-operative Limited (DFMC) and Australian Co-operative Foods Limited (ACF).

DFMC and ACF sought authorisation for the inclusion of the back to back milk purchasing policies and back to back pricing arrangements contained in clauses 4.4, 4.6.2 and 5.6 of the amended Milk Supply Agreement which will take effect as and from the Scheme Implementation Date. The back to back pricing and back to back purchasing policies are to apply to several agreements between ACF, DFMC and farmer members.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons. For the reasons set out in its determination, the ACCC has decided to grant authorisation for a period of five years.

Application for review

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 12 November 2008. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 13 November 2008.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
