## Australian Dental Association Inc applications for authorisation A91094 & A91095 – final determination

The Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (the ACCC) has issued a determination in respect of the application for authorisation lodged by the Australian Dental Association on 18 July 2008.

The Australian Dental Association sought authorisation for the making of, or giving effect to contracts, arrangements or understandings between two or more dentists and/or dental specialists who practice in a shared practice as to the fees to be charged for dental services provided in the practice.

The ACCC has decided to grant authorisation until 28 February 2013 to the Australian Dental Association for agreements as to the fees to be charged for dental services provided within shared practices with the following features:

a common practice trading name

- shared staff, for example, dental hygienists, administrative and support staff
- shared dental records and treatment of patients by other members of the practice a common reception and premises shared dental equipment and supplies.

A copy of the ACCC's determination is attached, including a summary of its reasons.

## **Application for review**

Pursuant to section 101 of the *Trade Practices Act 1974*, a person dissatisfied with this determination may apply to the Australian Competition Tribunal for its review. An application for review must be made within 21 days of the date of this determination; that is, on or before 31 December 2008. If no application to review is lodged by this date, the ACCC's determination will come into force on 1 January 2009.

An application for review of the ACCC's determination should be lodged directly with the Australian Competition Tribunal. The Australian Competition Tribunal is a separate body from the ACCC and is located within the Federal Court of Australia.
