Newcastle Port Corporation - applications for authorisation A91072 - A91074 interested party consultation

We refer to an ACCC email received 17 December 2007 in relation to the authorisation applications lodged by Newcastle Port Corporation ("**NPC**") to extend the PWCS Capacity Balancing System ("**CBS**") for 2008, with the clarification by NPC confirming 2008 nominations as the basis for any extension.

Xstrata wishes to confirm its support for an extension of the CBS as proposed by NPC for a maximum period of six months from 1 January 2008 subject to:

- The implementation of a Final CBS to be developed in the interim period (refer to Xstrata's submission of 14th December) is made retrospective from 1 January 2008. This was supported by Gary Webb, CEO of NPC, in a telephone conversation with Xstrata on Monday 17th 2008.
- The development of new access protocols and a commercial framework for the coal chain to apply from 1 July 2010 (refer to Xstrata's submission of 14th December) is completed by no later than 30 June 2008.
