Hi,

I wish to make comment about eBay plans to force users to only accept Paypal.

I am an irregular seller on eBay, and whilst I don't mind if I have to pay for things I buy via Paypal, I do object to being made to pay fees to sell the item on eBay, and then further fees to an eBay subsidiary to access the money for my item.

I have never had a problem using bank deposit, cheque or money order, nor has anyone I know. I fear that this proposed policy is just another attempt to extract more money from its users, in the disguise of a protection policy. Or is it that eBay wishes to wash its hands of the small amount of payment disputes that it actually receives? When all else fails, introduce a monopolising policy, and offer less service.

I sincerely hope that the ACCC will fully investigate this matter, and allow the users of eBay the option to pay for, or accept payment for, our items with the method we choose.
