eBay states that the move to force all transactions onto PayPal is to increase the safety of dealings due to PayPal's buyer protection scheme. If there is so much more protection under PayPal, then the same could be achieved by forcing all sellers to provide PayPal as an option, and letting the buyers decide if they want the protections offered through paypal, or would rather transfer money another way.
