On behalf of my Ebay on line Business (Mindyabiz) I would like make a public submission regarding notification N93365 made by eBay International A.G.

I am shattered that eBay can force users (at MY cost) to use of one of their subsidiaries - Paypal as the exclusive payment gateway for payments for auction goods and services.

Australia's banking system currently allows these same transactions to be processed no cost.

If eBay uses its market dominance to compel users to use ONLY a payment gateway THEY OWN as the sole method of making a payment for items purchased on their site, I believe consumer choice will have been lessened permanently - 30% of my Customers pay by "other means" and to be honest I have never had a problem with over 10,000 transactions... 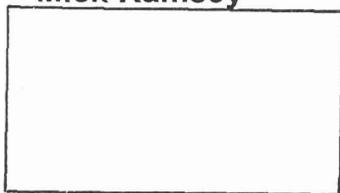
