Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you to register my disgust at eBay Australia's recent decision to implement a "PayPal" only policy for payment of items bought off the eBay auction website. My main concern with this decision is the loss of freedom of choice with regards to payment methods. Many eBay users do not feel comfortable in divulging sensitive credit card/bank account information to a internet finance portal such as PayPal, as they (rightly) believe in possible abuse of this sensitive information by third parties, and in some instances, even by PayPal itself. These users would much prefer to use alternate traditional methods of payment such as cash or direct bank deposit. With this in mind, I urge you to take swift action against eBay Australia's decision, in order to avoid this abhorrent denial of freedom of choice.
