I am a private ebay trader not a business trader.

I object to the limitations placed by Ebay on future payment methods as outlined on their website and the above notification.

I recently signed up with paypal , because I believed I had no choice

There are several reasons for my objection

1 The lodgement of my banking details along with everyone in a permanent register in USA is a worry. The temptation to access thousands of account details in one swoop is greater than trying to find them individually If I have several bank accounts I would have to register them all,not acceptable

2 The additional steps ,and therefore time ,taken between a buyer depositing money with paypal,paypal notifying me, me requesting release of funds, paypal transferring funds to my account

3 A new charge of \$1.00 for each transfer under \$150.00 (most of my sales are between \$10 - \$70) (so paypal earn interest on thousands of dollars sitting in their account until such time as it is withdrawn by its customers !)
sounds like a bank !

4 Too restrictive, the option to pay by bank cheque should remain. The right for me to permit a buyer to direct deposit to my chosen account should remain.
