As Paypal is a 100% owned subsidiary of Ebay, Ebay should be more transparent around their Paypal fees if sellers are forced to use Paypal as the only payment mechanism.

Ebay should not be allowed to charge separate Paypal fees, and any Paypal commission or transaction fees should be bundled into the final value fee that Ebay charges when an item is sold.

Potential sellers should be able to easily work out and compare the total selling costs (including listing fees, final value fees and transaction costs) between different online auction houses. If Ebay are overcharging for their services, then sellers are free to vote with their mice by selling their merchandise using other channels. Nobody is forced to sell on Ebay.
