To whom it may concern:

As you are aware, on 10 April 2008, eBay announced that:

- as of 21 May 2008, all items listed for sale on eBay.com.au must offer PayPal as one of the payment methods; and
- as of 17 June 2008, all items listed for sale must only offer payment via PayPal (or credit card transactions processed by PayPal) or cash on delivery.

I wish to raise my concerns about the conduct of eBay and don't believe that they should be able to dictate that buyers and sellers can only use PayPal for items bought and sold, and wish to lodge a public submission.

I believe that eBay's immunity under the TPA should be removed and people should be given the choice on how they pay for items purchased on eBay.
