Dear Sir/Madame,

As you are by now probably aware, Ebay will soon be imposing the mandatory use paypal payments for all transactions conducted on the website. I have been a seller on ebay for many years and have sold over 10,000 items, so i have a very good understanding of how everything works (and doesn't work).

I will not bore you with all of the details, as you would be aware of them now. What i will say is, that if ebay was serious about safety on the site, they would force sellers to verify there details (such as what is done with Oztion.com.au). It is a simple, quick and low cost alternative, and it is nothing more than pure revenue raising to do it any other way. ID verification is many times more secure than paypal (you only need to google paypal or talk to a business owner accepting paypal to learn of all the problems), alot cheaper, and very quick.

The bottom line is, buyers deserved to be kept safe and deserve choice. The Paypal only policy is far from safe and does not offer a choice.
