**RE: Objection to N93365 (Ebay's proposed exclusive use of PayPal)**

I would to submit my objection to Ebay's proposed policy of forcing it's buyers and sellers to exclusively use PayPal. It is my belief that a policy would dramitically reduce competition in online payments and consumer choice and is a perfect illustration of a business "using its superior bargaining power in an unconscionable way".

Any technical expert will attest that payments via online banking methods are no less unsafe than paypal and this is simply a thinly veiled attempt to garnish more revenue per online purchase. Given that Ebay actually owns PayPal, this makes the consumer vulnerable to future unjust rises in fee and other monopolistic behaviour.

I hope that given the ACCC's mandate of upholding the Trade Practices Act, that rejection of this proposal will be duly denied.
