Many of my customers are elderly people in their 80s that love writing me a cheque and that is all they know. They live in serviced units with their dial up internet. Their knowledge of the internet is basic. They figured out how to join ebay and how to bid, these people will NEVER join paypal - they will not join any type of thing where you have to put your name, address and credit card details. An 80 year-old will not do this!

Ebay are in contravention of the Trade Practices Act (third party forcing) I believe. The ACCC must act, make a ruling on this, please stop this, do not allow it. I am very worried for my future now and I cannot see how I can make a living on the site anymore. There is 100% outrage over this. Everyone is angry about it. Businesses that offer less methods of payment make less money than the ones that offer more, I cannot believe ebay thinks this is a good idea. Just crazy. Please help us ACCC only you have power to stop it.
