I don't feel that eBay changing to Pay Pal only payment is reasonable.

While it is meant to increase security and stop fraud, they are taking away the right of the seller and the buyer to control their transactions - if they are going to allow cash on delivery, then there should be no preclusion from them continuing to allow direct transfers to peoples' bank accounts (let alone that these changes 'double dip' on the eBay sellers, by taking a cut of the sale then a cut of the Pay Pal transaction).

By all means, eBay should work towards increasing security and mandating that Pay Pal must be an option for payment is fine - but mandating that it is the ONLY valid payment option (when it is owned by the same people) is unreasonable. I want to be able to direct transfer to somebody's account when I make purchases, and by doing so take full accountability for my actions -- that should be my choice.
