I have been a user of e-bay for 4 years in which time I have both bought and sold several items.

This makes me a low volume user, but I have been happy to buy or sell items locally, with both using pick up COD method of collection and payment. This is quite satisfactory for me, and I feel that a compulsory registration for a payment method I do not wish to use is quite unfair.

Using pay pal would mean additional fees to e-bay with no actual security for items that are posted, as the recipient simply has to claim they did not receive the item. I have heard of this happening to other e-bay users.
