Dear Sir/Mme.,

Please accept my submission opposing eBay International AG's intended enforcement of sole payment by PayPal.

As a small time buyer only (I have sold nothing by eBay), I record that my experience of PayPal has been such that I now no longer buy an article if PayPal is required for payment. PayPal just is not good enough, especially when buying from a US supplier.

I have tried to raise this matter with eBay, but there is no obvious correspondence route. I wrote an email to their general comments section. In that email, I suggested eBay employ whoever set up and maintains Amazon's credit card payment service, which has always been trouble free for me. I received no acknowledgement of receipt of the correspondence.

Why enforce a payment system that is unreliable?
