I am writing in opposition to the eBay proposed forced usage of Paypal effective 17 June 2008.

As an eBay user I have only ever accepted payments by Direct Deposit to my bank account, paid for items by direct deposit or used the cash on pick up scenario (for both sales and purchases).

I am appalled that I should be prevented from acceptng the most convenient payment method that I wish to use, and then not being able to charge a percentage to cover the paypal fees. As a buyer, I am appalled that I will in effect have to pay more for goods precisely because sellers will have to hid the new fees and restrictions in their listing prices.

All for the privilege of using a service I do not require, need or want.

This is another disgraceful example of double dipping and as usual it is the consumer who pays..

I cannot see how the ACCC would allow this to go ahead.
