I strongly object to being forced to use PayPal for the use of payment when selling items on eBay. The forced imposition of a 2.4% surcharge to the seller and eBay's restriction of passing on these fees contravenes earlier rulings regarding the passing on of fees to purchasers. This is similar to credit card fees that can be legally passed on to purchasers and has already .
