Mr Turner called to provide an oral submission regarding this matter.

Mr Turner advised that he had an eBay shop for a few years. On his site, he displayed a 'Paymate' code indicating that customers could pay via Paymate. Mr Turner complained that without his permission, a representative from eBay removed the Paymate logo off the site.

Mr Turner was of the view that eBay's requirement that all users use PayPal to conduct transactions is anti-competitive. Mr Turner further submits that eBay are 'lining their pockets' and the notified conduct is not in the public interest.

Mr Turner disputed eBay's claims regarding PayPal being the 'most secure' method of payment. Mr Turner contends that the protection provided by banks is equally as secure.
