Gentlemen,

In April, eBay informed all users that:

- as of 21 May 2008, all items listed for sale on eBay.com.au must offer PayPal as one of the payment methods; and
- as of 17 June 2008, all items listed for sale must only offer payment via PayPal (or credit card transactions processed by PayPal) or cash on delivery.

I strongly object to this proposed new rule. Some of the people who buy from me on eBay, pay by check or money order or direct bank transfer, either because they don't trust PayPal or they just don't want to use it. That is not just customers in the USA. I do have a number of buyers in Australia, and they don't all want to pay using PayPal. As eBay owns PayPal, insisting on only PayPal as a payment method, could be considered against the Australian & U.S. anti-trust laws.

I strongly urge you to block eBay from implementing the proposed new rules.
