I have read many of the submissions against the proposed conduct and the ACCC's draft notice of revocation. I am appalled by the indifference that Ebay has displayed towards the ACCC's draft notice, by announcing that the changes will take effect as from the 15th of July.

I have also read the eBay notification and their submissions to the ACCC about exclusive dealing. I am appalled at the arrogance they display towards the ACCC, and eBay members. I agree with the ACCC's draft notice as I believe eBay's proposed conduct would decrease competition and not have an overall public benefit.

I was one of the almost 700 people/organisations that lodged a submission against eBay's proposal.

eBay only provides the conduit for the transactions between buyer and seller and is in no way involved in the transaction.

I would appreciate you taking into account my additional comments in this email and thank you for your valued consideration of the matter. I look forward to hearing of the final revocation of immunity for eBay's restrictive payment policy in order to restore a free trading environment.
