To whom it may concern,

I have read the eBay notification and their submissions to the ACCC about exclusive dealing. I have also read many submissions against the proposed conduct and the ACCC's draft notice of revocation.

I agree with the ACCC's draft notice as I believe eBay's proposed conduct would decrease competition and not have an overall public benefit. It takes away from the consumers right of choice and doesn't allow for fair choices and trading for all. By being forced to use Paypal only, we are forced to pay more in fees. In conjunction with eBay's updated feedback rating system, where a seller is penalized with higher fees for having slightly below perfect feedback (all the more likely now that sellers can not leave negative feedback for buyers but buyers can freely leave them for sellers), fees are already going to be increased for an increasing number of sellers. We deserve the right to choose which payment method we accept and therefore which fees we want to pay or bypass.

I therefore would like to lodge my complaint against eBay's proposed immunity and give my permission to place this on the Public Register.
