In reply to your correspondence of the 12th of JUNE inviting submissions in relation to the above. I have read the eBay notification and their submissions to the ACCC about exclusive dealing. I was one of the ebayers that lodged a Submission against this request and have read many of the others. I have also read the ACCC's draft notice of revocation. Please allow me to voice my strong support regarding the ACCC's recent decision to revoke the notification regarding eBay's "PayPal only" policy, originally intended to begin on the 17th June 2008.

eBay's attempts to mandate these policies is un-Australian and anti-choice. To thinly disguise the implementation of a "Paypal only" rule as safety based and not purely financial is an insult to the intelligence of the people and the Government and agencies that represent them.

With this in mind I urge you to uphold your decision to maintain a variety of available payment options within the eBay marketplace. I hope you agree that a mandatory, monopolistic payment regime is ethically and perhaps legally wrong.

I am sure that thousands of Australian eBay members will join me in saying thank you for the only reasonable decision to be reached by the ACCC.
